

In line with the decisions taken by the Communicable Diseases High Committee, TRNC Ministry of Health has decided to apply the criteria for entry to the country between 22nd November 2021 and 28th November 2021 as follows.

People coming to our country by sea-air routes and those coming from outside the island who enter by using the land border gates must fill in their digital travel documents and set up their records as stated below before travelling.

To create a Digital Travel Document:

- It is mandatory to download the Stay Safe application from Apple Store or Android Market to your smart devices, create a Digital Travel Document from within the application, and keep this with you digitally upon entry.
- Those who do not have a smart device must fill out the Digital Travel Document at www.guvendekalkkktc.com. They must keep the completed form with them when they enter the country, either digitally or as a printout.

People who will enter our country and who do not need to go into quarantine according to the country entry criteria, will create a Digital Travel Document from the “Travel Code Transactions” section of the “Stay Safe Application”. *(People who will enter our country between the ages of 6-12 will also create a Digital Travel Document from this section)*

On the condition that they show their residence address in our country, people, who need to go into quarantine according to the country entry criteria, will create a Digital Travel Document from the “Wristband Transactions” section of the “Stay Safe Application” *(except those under 12 years old)*.

People, who do not provide an address of residence in our country and who will stay in central quarantine in designated central quarantine hotels according to the colour codes of the country they come from, will create a Digital Travel Document from the “Travel Code Transactions” section of the “Stay Safe Application”.

Citizens of the Republic of Turkey can upload their HES codes, vaccination documents and PCR test results to the Digital Travel Document.

People who will enter the country can save their vaccination documents and PCR test results by using the cameras of their devices to scan the QR code on the vaccination documents and PCR test results with the QR reader in the application.

Passengers must keep the uploaded PCR and vaccine information with them digitally or as a printout, as they will be checked upon entry to the TRNC.

Creating a Digital Travel Document will be required for people aged 6 years and over.

1 B) RULES TO BE APPLIED ACCORDING TO COUNTRY CODES

DARK RED;

- People who have travelled to these countries in the last 14 days regardless of whether or not they have been vaccinated;
 - Pre-departure negative PCR result from the last 72 hours.
 - 10 days quarantine
 - **Covid-19 test to be performed at the end of quarantine.**

RED;

- **VACCINATED or HAVE HAD THE DISEASE;**
- Pre-departure negative PCR result from the last 72 hours.
- Quarantine-free entry

UNVACCINATED;

- Pre-departure negative PCR result from the last 72 hours.
- 7 days quarantine.
- **Covid-19 test to be performed at the end of quarantine.**

ORANGE;

- **VACCINATED or HAVE HAD THE DISEASE;**
- Pre-departure negative PCR result from the last 72 hours.
- Quarantine-free entry

- **UNVACCINATED;**
- Pre-departure negative PCR result from the last 72 hours.
- 5 days quarantine.
- **Covid-19 test to be performed at the end of quarantine.**

GREEN;

- **VACCINATED or HAVE HAD THE DISEASE;**
- No restrictions.

- **UNVACCINATED;**
- Pre-departure negative PCR result from the last 72 hours.
- Quarantine-free

entry.

GENERAL RULES;

1. Vaccinated people: Who have completed the vaccination programme. From 14 days after the last dose.

SINOVAC: 2 DOSES

BIONTECH: 2 DOSES

SINOPHARM: 2 DOSES

COMIRNATY (Pfizer/Biontech): 2 DOSES

VAXZEVRIA (Astrazeneca/Oxford): 2 DOSES

COVID-19 Vaccine Janssen / Johnson and Johnson: 1 DOSE

SPUTNIK V: 2 DOSES

MODERNA: 2 DOSES

NOVAVAX: 2 DOSES

People will be considered vaccinated if they receive two different doses of the vaccines specified above.

People who have had the Covid-19 disease and received 1 dose of vaccine will be considered as vaccinated.

2. People who have had the disease: Submit a positive PCR test result taken between 30-180 days prior to travel. These people will be evaluated as vaccinated people.

3. Children under the age of 18 will be able to enter the country with parents who are vaccinated or who have had the disease as stated above based on the category of the country they have travelled from and in accordance with the PCR test rules (children who are 6 years old and over).

4. Passengers will be evaluated based on the country that is in the highest risk group among the countries they have set foot in/ been in, in the last 10 days.

5. Results of PCR tests will only be accepted in Turkish, English and French.

6. PCR test results will not be requested from children aged 0-5 who will enter the country.
7. Passengers arriving from the Republic of Turkey to the TRNC will be required to have a QR code on their PCR test results.

INLAND BORDER CROSSING RULES

Based on the results of the epidemiological assessment within the island, “LEVEL 3” rules will be applied at the crossings.

Level 3 : Double vaccinated people with EMA-approved vaccines, as well as the Sinovac, Sinopharm or Sputnik vaccines, can cross with a 7-day negative rapid antigen test or PCR test, 14 days after their final dose (1st dose if Johnson& Johnson).

Unvaccinated people (including unvaccinated workers and people who will cross for health reasons) can cross with a 72-hour negative rapid antigen test or PCR test.

However, unvaccinated secondary education (middle and high school) students and people residing in Kato Pyrgos will be able to cross with a 7-day negative rapid antigen test or PCR test. (A total of 500/100,000 people in 14 days)

*People requesting to come to our country from Orange-Green Colour Category Countries via South Cyprus will be processed according to the country entry criteria stated above in “1 B”. However, **VACCINATED PEOPLE** who will come to our country from Orange Colour Category countries who cannot submit a 72-hour PCR test, will be able to enter our country on the condition that they have a Covid-19 test at the land border gates.

*People coming from Orange-Green Colour Category countries and staying in South Cyprus for more than 10 days will be processed within the scope of the Inland Border Crossing rules if they wish to cross into our country.

* The inland border crossing rule will apply to people who have come to South Cyprus once they have stayed in South Cyprus for a period of 10 days.

*** On touristic coach tours to be arranged from South Cyprus to our country, unvaccinated tourists from Orange-Red countries will be able to cross for the day provided that they present a negative PCR/antigen test conducted within the last 72**

THE CRITERIA AND THE RULES TO BE FOLLOWED FOR THOSE WHO STAY IN HOME QUARANTINE WITH WRISTBANDS

People who are required to enter quarantine based on the above criteria will be able to spend their quarantine periods of 5-7-10-14 days, depending on the country of origin, at their specified address of residence, provided that they show their address of residence in our country and download the “Stay Safe Application” before coming to the country. They will go to the address of residence they have committed to spending their quarantine in,

either alone or in the company of a driver, or by public transport, taxi, touristic minibus authorised vehicles determined by the Ministry of Finance.

– People over the age of 65 and people who go abroad for health reasons will be able to download the “Stay Safe Application” after they arrive in the country.

– Children under the age of 12 will not be wearing wristbands.

People who do not comply with the aforementioned rules, who do not provide an address of residence in our country and who want to come to our country will stay in central quarantine for 5-14 days, depending on the country they come from, in designated central quarantine hotels.

*It is recommended that people who do not comply with the home quarantine rules are sent to central quarantine, pay for their own quarantine fees, and that criminal proceedings are launched against them in accordance with the relevant legislation.
